Data Protection Notice

1. This data protection notice informs you about data processing within our company.

2. We process the following personal data:

- First and last name, title, if applicable
- Mailing address(es)
- Telephone number(s), fax number(s) if applicable
- E-Mail address(es)
- Registration/vehicle data
- Information required for the proper execution of the contract

3. We process personal data for the **purpose** of:

- Executing and managing the contractual relationship, including correspondence.,
- Sending newsletters, price lists, advertising, current information and events
- Fulfillment of our contractual and legal obligations and
- Processing of mutual claims
(e.g., invoicing, performance, remuneration, and liability claims, etc.).

4. The **legal basis** for data processing is

- Art. 6 (1) (b) GDPR for the performance of the contract and pre-contractual measures,
- Art. 6 (1) (c) GDPR for the fulfillment of legal obligations,
- Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR, insofar as data processing is necessary to protect the legitimate interests of us or a third party,
- Art. 6 (1) (a) GDPR, insofar as you have given us your consent to process the personal data concerning you for specific purposes.

5. The transmission of personal data to third parties only takes place within the framework of the contractual relationship, granted consents and legal regulations to the following recipients:

- Tax advisors, tax authorities
- Shipping company
- Banks, credit institutions, credit card companies
- Contract processors (e.g. data centers, IT service providers, printing service providers, letter shops, waste disposal companies, etc.) whose services we use,
- Depending on the order, to other recipients that we will coordinate with you

6. Data will only be transferred to third countries (countries outside the European Economic Area – EEA) if this is necessary to execute the contract (e.g. payment orders, shipping) or if you have given us your consent or if this is otherwise permitted by law.

7. We will store your personal data for the duration of the statutory retention periods. This is generally 10 years, plus a grace period of an additional four years to record cases of potential suspension of data expiration. After 14 years, we will review whether there are grounds for further retention.

You have the following rights as a “data subject” whose data we process:

- Right to information pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR
- Right to rectification pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR
- Right to erasure (“to be forgotten”) pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR
- Right to restrict processing in accordance with Art. 18 GDPR
- Right to transfer your data in a structured, common, and machine-readable format in accordance with Art. 20 GDPR

To the extent that we process your personal data for specific purposes based on your consent, you have the right to revoke your consent at any time according to Art. 7 (3) GDPR. Upon receipt of your revocation, we will stop processing your data for the purposes for which you granted your consent. The legality of the processing prior to receipt of your revocation remains unaffected.

Right of objection: If we process your personal data to protect legitimate interests within the meaning of Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR, you have the right to object to this processing for reasons arising from your particular situation pursuant to Art. 21 (1) GDPR. You can object to processing for direct marketing purposes at any time without giving reasons pursuant to Art. 21 (2) GDPR. To exercise your right of objection, simply send us an informal email to info@dasis.de stating which data processing you object to.

If you believe that the processing of personal data concerning you violates the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority (usually the State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information) pursuant to Art. 77 (1) GDPR. The complaint can be lodged, in particular, with the supervisory authority responsible for your habitual residence, place of work, or place of the alleged violation.
